Nursery

At Colégio Júlio Dinis International School, affection, care, and attention form the foundation of our daily nursery routine.

Recognising the immense responsibility of welcoming children at such a young age, we provide a safe and nurturing environment that supports their growth and well-being. Our dedicated team ensures that each child's daily routines—feeding, sleep, and hygiene—are met with care and consistency, always respecting their individual pace and needs.

The first three years of life are crucial for a child's physical, intellectual, and emotional development. Through daily interactions, babies develop a strong bond of affection with our team, fostering a sense of security and trust in both the adults and their surroundings.

With plenty of cuddles and affection, babies experience their first milestones and learning moments, discovering themselves and the world around them. Our approach includes stimulating, exploratory, and creative educational activities, laying the groundwork for curiosity, confidence, and joyful learning.

Early Years

Nurture, encourage, and explore - these are the fundamental pillars of our daily routine in Early Years.

Understanding the important responsibility of guiding young children, we create a safe and engaging environment that supports their holistic growth and development.

The Early Years are critical for a child's social, emotional, and cognitive development. By respecting each child's individual pace and unique interests, we establish daily routines that foster play, learning, and discovery. Through these interactions, children build strong connections with our team, feeling valued, secure, and confident in both the adults and the space around them.



With laughter and shared moments, children achieve important milestones and embark on exciting learning adventures, discovering themselves and the vibrant world around them through a variety of stimulating, interactive, and creative educational activities.

As part of the Early Years routine, we integrate a diverse and engaging educational program, including English (Cambridge English Program), Musical Expression, Physical Expression and Movement and the Emotions Workshop. Additionally, we run several special projects common to all Early Years: Now, I Speak! (Agora Falo Eu!), Now, I choose! (Agora Escolho Eu!), Day On Wheels (Dia Sobre Rodas), Loose Parts Area and an Educational Garden.

The 4 and 5-year-old groups also take part in the 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 project. Additionally, 5-year-olds engage in the I'm a Graduate (Sou Finalista) and Community Puzzle projects.

Recognising that every part plays a vital role in the educational journey, our teaching approach is based on the strong connection between the school, the child, and the family, fostering shared experiences and integrating them into the group's daily routine.

Lower and Upper School (years 5-9)

Education is a continuous process of holistic and intentional development, and in Basic Education, it is essential to establish the core pillars of our Educational Project.

To achieve this, we create learning environments that foster autonomous and responsible students, open to change, adaptable to a multicultural and digital world, and proficient in English. Colégio Júlio Dinis International School has developed a flexible model for this stage of education, led by a team of dedicated teachers who ensure a diverse curricular and extracurricular offering, always placing the student at the centre of the learning process.

With a strong focus on autonomy and curricular flexibility, we promote meaningful learning experiences through a contextualised curriculum, allowing students to engage in varied activities and projects aligned with the Educational Project, including:

- The Artistic Component (Theatre, Dance, Choir, Music Academy, and the Creative Arts Workshop);
- The Technological and Scientific Component (Robotics, The Inventors, Technology in Action, and Science in Reaction);



- The Sports Component (Rugby, Volleyball, Football, Basketball, Swimming, Chess, and Martial Arts);
- Themed Rooms (Study+, the Numbers and Letters Lab, and subjectspecific clubs for Portuguese, Mathematics, and English, as well as initiatives in Health and the Junior eTwinning Academy).
- The school also engages in Projects such as eTwinning, Erasmus+, and Eco-Schools.

By offering a strong foundation for academic progression, Colégio Júlio Dinis International School also fosters closer relationships with families, ensuring that students develop the essential skills and knowledge needed for Upper/ Secondary School (3rd Cycle) and beyond.

Secondary Education

At Colégio Júlio Dinis International School, Secondary Education is designed as both a consolidation of key knowledge from previous years and a preparation for the challenges of university-level education.

Recognising that education is a continuous journey, and in alignment with the core pillars of our Educational Project, the curricula for our three study pathways—Science and Technology, Languages and Humanities, and Socioeconomic Sciences—are structured to promote greater autonomy and responsibility. This approach ensures an interdisciplinary connection between concepts across different curricular areas, equipping students with the critical skills needed for future academic and professional challenges.

Under the guidance of a dedicated team of teachers, who focus on meeting students' individual needs and enhancing their learning experience, Colégio Júlio Dinis International School provides a broad range of activities and strategies to ensure a diverse and enriching curriculum that fosters learning development and academic success.

Offers:

 Supplementary lessons and specialised study groups in core subjects (Portuguese, Mathematics A, Physics & Chemistry A, Biology & Geology);



- Exam preparation classes, available from the beginning of the academic year.
- Weekly support sessions for multiple subjects (*Portuguese, Mathematics A, Philosophy, Biology & Geology, Economics A, History A, Geography A, and MACS*), starting from Year 10.
- Possibility of subject substitution, allowing students to exchange one biennial or annual subject within their study programme for a corresponding subject from a different course, in accordance with Decree 226-A/2018;
- Personal and Social Development Sessions (from Year 10 onwards), designed to monitor student performance and provide guidance towards choosing the most suitable university course;
- eTwinning Programme; Erasmus+; Eco-Schools Programme.

By combining academic rigour with a variety of learning strategies, Colégio Júlio Dinis International School ensures that each student develops the necessary independence and progress to confidently face their future.

6. Extracurricular Activities

 have the opportunity to develop technological projects, learn programming, and

- Chess: An excellent activity for enhancing concentration, strategic thinking, and problem-solving skills. Students can participate in both internal and external tournaments, refining their cognitive abilities.
- Dance and Creative Dance: Dance is an artistic expression that promotes coordination, creativity, and emotional expression. Creative Dance allows students to explore new movements and develop their own artistic identity.
- Ballet: Ballet helps students develop discipline, posture, and flexibility. It also
 provides an opportunity for artistic expression through classical dance while
 enhancing motor and artistic skills.
- Design Thinking: A creative methodology that teaches students how to solve problems innovatively. Through this practice, they develop critical thinking, collaboration skills, and the ability to find effective solutions to complex challenges.
- **Acrobatic Gymnastics**: Helps students build strength, flexibility, and coordination while working together in performances and competitions.
- Natação: A full-body physical activity that enhances endurance, muscle strength, and motor coordination. Students have the opportunity to compete and refine their aquatic skills.
