

 - **Black** for non-recyclable waste
 - **Yellow** for plastic and metal

Inform:
Distinguish what is natural on the beach from what is litter:

- What is natural on the beach (e.g., shells, sea snails, seaweed, etc.) must be left in its habitat.
- Collect only what is considered marine litter (all materials abandoned or improperly disposed of by humans).
